GIRLS - 11:30 a.m.

BOYS - 12:10 p.m.

COURSE – Each gender will run the same course of 3200 meters. The course is set up as two loops of 1600 meters so the spectators will have plenty of opportunity to watch. A map will be found at adesports.com, under the MS CC Championship tab.

ENTRIES – Due on athletic.net by Tuesday, October 1st at 10 a.m. The event is listed as Wisconsin MS Cross Country Championship. If you do not have an account, do not wait to set this up as you are not granted immediate access.

ENTRY FEE – The entry fee is \$200 per school with unlimited number of students to participate as well as a \$25 per individual fee if you are bringing an incomplete team (Team = 5 students). The entry fee will once again be collected online on athletic.net when you register your team. You will not have access to registration prior to credit card authorization.

TEAM/BUS parking — Buses will unload and be directed as to where to park. Buses are to unload between 9:30 a.m. until 10:15 a.m.
